


Year 4's Home Learning- Week commencing 13th July

It sounds like a horn. With an adult, take a balloon, put 3 small screws/washers or rounded hard objects in. Blow it up, tie it, swirl it round. Listen to the sound, it should be the same as the vuvuzela!</p>
