

#### Manchester

Manchester is a landlocked city located in the North West of England.

It is the UK's second largest city after London.

Most of Manchester is urban, although there are some rural areas

### **Key Vocabulary**

Coast— the land next to the sea.

Landlocked—having no direct access to the sea.

City—a large or important town.

Climate—the usual weather conditions in an area or place.

Landmarks— a building or place that is of historical or cultural importance.

Man made—produced, formed or made by humans.

Natural—existing in or formed by nature.

Human geography—features on the land that are made by humans.

Physical geography—features on the land that are formed by nature.

Rural—living in the country side.

Urban—living in a city.

Population—the number of people living in a place.

Cape Town is South Africa's second largest city.

It has a warm climate and is located on the South-West coast.

One of it's most famous features is Table Top mountain that has a distinctive flat
