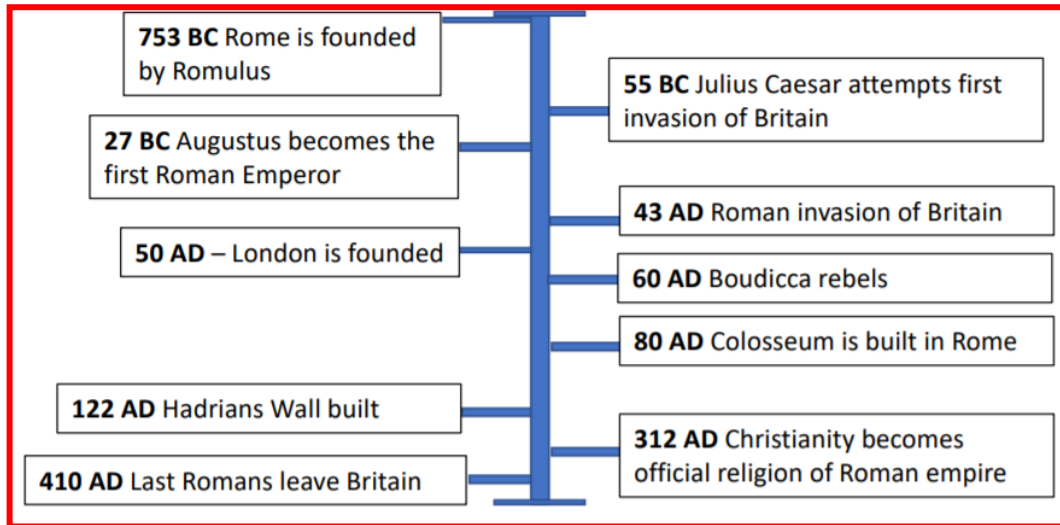

## Important Places

### Hadrians Wall

Stretching 73 miles, Hadrian's Wall was a stone barrier to separate the Romans invasion to Britain from Scotland. Hadrian's Wall was built in 122AD and took 14 years!



### Colosseum in Rome

It is the largest amphitheatre ever built. It could hold between 50,000—80,000 spectators and was used for gladiatorial contest.

## Why did the Romans invade Britain?

**Goods** - Wool / gold / coal / lead / leather / corn.

**Power** - By conquering more and more countries to make them more powerful.

**Ambition** - It took the Romans three attempts at invading Britain before they conquered.

**Revenge** - People in Britain had been helping the French fight against the Romans so they invade Britain

### Boudicca

She was the Celtic queen was famous for rising up against the Roman empire. The name Boudicca means Victory.

### Julius Caesar

He was the first person to take control of the Roman Empire. He fell in love with the Egyptian Queen Cleopatra.
