

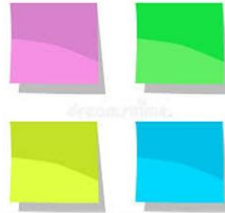
Maths – Number 7



- Find 7 objects around your house. Find different ways to split 'partition' them. For example 'I am 7, I am 3+4'
- Practise forming the number 7 'Across the sky and slant the line, makes a seven every time'
- Practise forming your numbers 0-20

English - Labels

- Can you use some post it notes or pieces of paper to label objects around your house?
- Sing the song 'heads, shoulders, knees and toes and then label a family member.



Science – Sense of smell

- Explore your sense of smell at home.
- You could make some smelly pots and decide which smell you like the best / least.
- You could ask an adult to blindfold you and conduct a smell test – can you guess the item from the smell?
