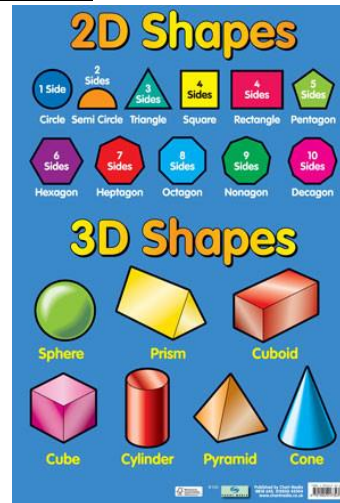
Speaking
