NURSERY	<p>In EYFS, Art and Design is approached in a range of ways. Different art opportunities are available every day in the art and craft areas, where children will find a range of materials with which they can explore and create. Children will also regularly take part in a guided draw session. These sessions are facilitated by the use of step-by-step images and teacher modelling and children will, over time, build a bank of drawings that they are able to produce and they will also begin to develop an awareness of shape, scale and the ability to be reflective about their art. Across the year, children have access to six teacher-led art projects that link to other areas of the curriculum. In all areas of the art curriculum in EYFS, children have the opportunity to work independently and collaboratively to allow them to both express themselves and develop their skills and knowledge by sharing with their peers. To allow and show progression from the beginning of Nursery to the end of Reception, directed tasks and guided draws will increase in complexity and children will work in a sketchbook to record their art.</p>
