Key Vocabulary

Map—A map is a drawing of all or part of Earth's surface. Maps show us where things are. Maps may show rivers and lakes, forests, buildings, and roads. Most maps are drawn on a flat surface.

Key—A map key is sometimes also called a legend. Legends or map keys use symbols, colours, or lines to represent important places or landmarks on a map.

Symbol— A simple mark or sign to represent an idea

Hill— A naturally raised area of land

Valley - A low area of land between hills or mountains
