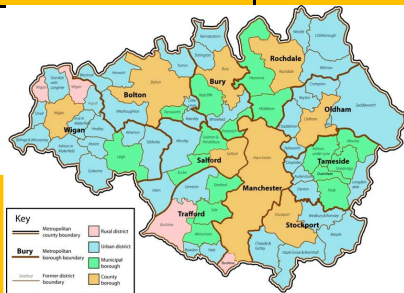
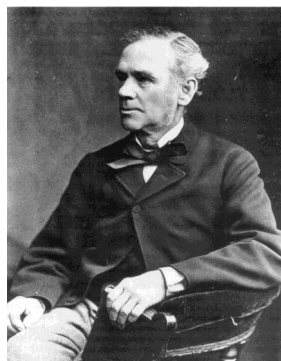

Hugh Mason

- ◇ Born in Stalybridge in 1817.
- ◇ Owned a cotton mill.
- ◇ Became an MP and mayor of Ashton-Under-Lyne



Manchester:

Ashton-Under-Lyne is a town in Tameside. So is Stalybridge. The nearest city to Tameside is Manchester. Manchester is the 3rd largest city in England.

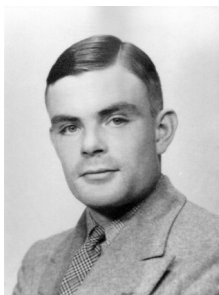
Emmeline Pankhurst

- ◇ Born in Manchester in 1858
- ◇ Was part of the suffragettes
- ◇ Noticed how men and women were treated differently
- ◇ She fought for men and women's equal right to vote



Alan Turing

- ◇ Born in London in 1912.
- ◇ Was a mathematician.
- ◇ Created the enigma code during World War II.



Key Vocabulary

Code: A system where letters, numbers and symbols mean something different, often used as part of a secret.

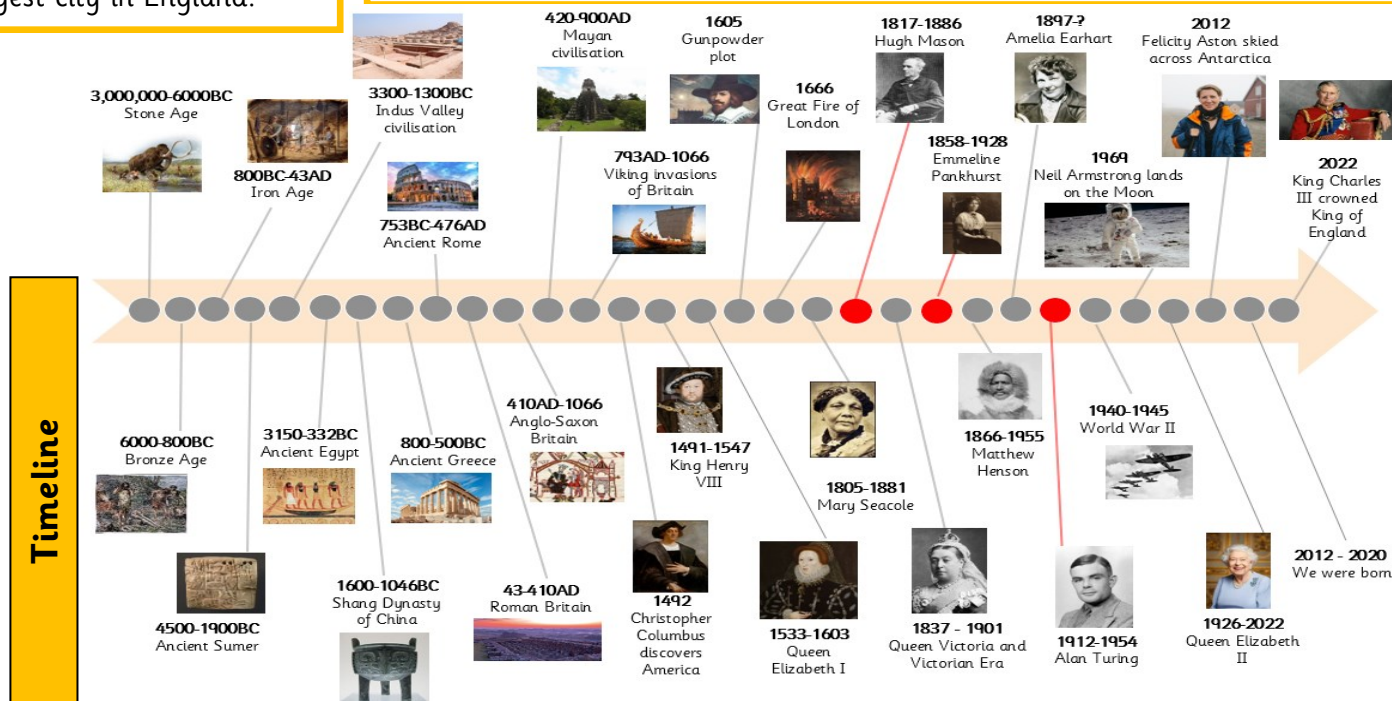
Decoding: understanding the meaning of a code.

Equality: Everybody having the same rights and opportunities.

Mathematician: someone who does maths for a living.

Retired: When someone who used to work doesn't anymore, often because of their age.

MP: a member of the parliament.
